Preface

The 21st International Congress of the International Society for Forensic Genetics was held from the 13th to the 16th of September 2005 in Ponta Delgada, The Azores, Portugal. The presidents of the congress were Professor António Amorim, Institute of Molecular Pathology and Immunology, University of Porto (IPATIMUP), Portugal, and Professor Francisco Corte-Real, National Institute of Legal Medicine and University of Coimbra, Portugal.
